



Conference Health Plan- CHP

Changes for 2010

Lay Employees

PPO (\$500 deductible plan)

The maximum out of pocket limit will increase from \$2,000/\$4,000 single/family to \$2,500/\$5,000 single/family. (Please remember that copayments for office visits and prescriptions do not count toward your out of pocket limit)

Prescription copayments will increase from \$10/20/35 to \$12/25/40 for 30 day retail prescription purchases. Mail order purchases will be 2x the copayment, this will give you a 90 day supply and save you 1 copayment.

Outpatient and Inpatient Mental Health and Substance Abuse services will no longer have calendar year visit limits. These services will be considered the same as medical services.

HMO

The maximum out of pocket limit will increase from \$2,000/\$4,000 single/family to \$2,500/\$5,000 single/family. (Please remember that copayments for prescriptions do not count toward your out of pocket limit)



HMO cont.

The inpatient hospital copayment will increase to \$200 per day. It will have a maximum limit of \$1,000 per admission.

The emergency room, out patient surgery and advanced diagnostic imaging copayments will increase from \$100 to \$150.

Prescription copayments will increase from \$10/20/35 to \$12/25/40 for 30 day retail prescription purchases. Mail order purchases will be 2x the co-payment, this will give you a 90 day supply and save you 1 copayment.

Outpatient and Inpatient Mental Health and Substance Abuse services will no longer have calendar year visit limits and the copayments will be the same as medical services.
